

## 2021 Cruise In Car Show Award Winners

Thanks to all participants, volunteers, sponsors, and the Castle Rock Downtown Merchants Association for making the 13th Annual Classic Rock Car Show a huge success. With a sold out car show of over 300 cars registered, the Vintage Car Club presented 60 awards in a variety of categories that included a Survivor Award, Long Distance Traveled Award, Hottest Car (picked by the Fire Chief), Most Likely to Get Pulled Over (picked by the Police Chief), Castle Rock's Mayor Choice, and Best of Show.

The Vintage Car Club selects and recognizes the top vehicles by class as equal winners. Therefore, there are no first, second, or third place winners by class. Also, the number of trophies awarded for each class is determined annually based on the average number of cars per class that have registered for the car show over the past 3 years.
