

## 2024 Cruise In Car Show Award Winners

Thanks to all participants, volunteers, sponsors (Douglas Lodge 153, Garage Condos, and Wheel Pros) and the Castle Rock Downtown Merchants Association for making the 16th Annual Classic Rock Car Show a huge success. With a sold out car show of 339 registered cars, the Vintage Car Club presented 64 awards in a variety of categories that included 18 separate car classes, a survivor award, long distance traveled award, hottest car (picked by the fire chief), most likely to get pulled over (picked by the police chief), castle rock's mayor choice, and best of show.

The Vintage Car Club selects and recognizes the top vehicles by class as equal winners. Therefore, there are no first, second, or third place winners by class. Also, the number of trophies awarded for each class is determined based on the average number of cars registered (approximately 1 trophy per 4.5 cars registered in a class).
