

2026 Cruise In Car Show Award Winners

Thanks to all participants, volunteers, sponsors (Les Schwab Tire Center Castle Rock, Douglas Lodge 153, Mountainside Auto Refinement, Legacy Auto Clinic, Vik Kustoms, and Leaf Filter) for making the 18th Annual Classic Rock Car Show a huge success. With a sold out car show of 355 registered cars, the Vintage Car Club presented 82 awards in a variety of categories that included 20 separate car classes, blue ribbon awards, coolest ford, survivor award, long distance traveled award, hottest car (picked by the fire chief), most likely to get pulled over (picked by the police chief), castle rock's mayor choice, and best of show.

The Vintage Car Club selects and recognizes the top vehicles by class as equal winners. Therefore, there are no first, second, or third place winners by class. Also, the number of trophies awarded for each class is determined based on the average number of cars registered (approximately 1 trophy per 4.5 cars registered in each class).
